2011-2016 Articulation Agreement Suffolk County Community College and Five Towns College

Purposes of Agreement

This agreement between Five Towns College and Suffolk County Community College is intended to provide a seamless transfer between the two schools, upon the students graduation from Suffolk County Community College. The agreement specifically stipulates the benefits to Suffolk County Community College students transferring to Five Towns College upon the completion of their associate degree. The agreement also addresses the responsibilities of each institution in communicating these benefits to all relevant constituents for the purpose of facilitating an informed and smooth transfer process.

I. Admissions

1. Upon completion and submission of all necessary application materials, Suffolk County Community College graduates will be admitted to Five Towns College with the cumulative G.P.A. received upon graduation from Suffolk County Community College, with the following exceptions:

Suffolk County Community College graduates from the following programs must attain the minimum G.P.A. for Admission:

- •Childhood Education: minimum cumulative G.P.A. will be 2.75
- 2. To facilitate the process of admissions, Five Towns College agrees to provide a designated transfer admissions representative for graduates of Suffolk County Community College.
- 3. Five Towns College will coordinate with Suffolk County Community College to schedule at least two (2) on-site admissions events per year, where students will be advised at all Suffolk County Community College campuses about Five Towns College's programs, admissions process and scholarships.
- 4. The application fee for Five Towns College will be waived for Suffolk County Community College students who apply at any of these events.

II. Registration

Suffolk County Community College students who have been accepted to Five Towns College and have paid their tuition deposit will be permitted to register during early registration at the same time as their Five Towns College student counterparts.

III. Communication

- 1. Five Towns College and Suffolk County Community College agree to cooperate in communicating with each other and with their respective constituents about the relationship between the two institutions. Faculty and staff at both institutions will share the information provided in this agreement with interested and qualified students. Five Towns College and Suffolk County Community College agree to provide counseling and advisement to students and to prospective students about this agreement and its inherent benefits.
- 2. Suffolk County Community College will promote Five Towns College in any publications and/or websites that discuss transfer options and agreements. Suffolk County Community College will also distribute and make available any appropriate Five Towns College printed materials.
- 3. An administrator from Five Towns College will implement this agreement at Five Towns College and communicate changes to those parties to whom the information is pertinent. The same will be true at Suffolk County Community College.

IV. Terms of Agreement

- 1. This agreement becomes effective on the date of signature by representatives of the institutions. It may be modified or terminated at any time by either institution with appropriate notification and by mutual consent.
- 2. In the event it is decided at any time to modify or terminate this agreement, commitments made to individual students already in the program will continue in effect for the terms applicable at the time the student enrolled in the program.
- 3. This agreement will be effective for five (5) years, commencing no later than the Fall 2011 semester, and will be renewed automatically for another five (5) years, unless either party objects and provides written notification to the other party.

V. Transfer of Credits

- 1. Suffolk County Community College students who graduate with A.S., A.A.S. and A.A. degrees will have their course credits transferred to Five Towns College in their enrolled program of study providing that they have received a grade of "C" or higher in each course and that these courses are appropriate for that degree program at Five Towns College. Students should be able to graduate in two years providing they enroll for full-time study at Five Towns College and do not change their majors.
- 2. To prepare Suffolk County Community College students to transfer to Five Towns College, a meeting with Five Towns College Admissions will be arranged so that each student is provided with a plan of study for fulfilling his/her bachelor's degree requirements.
- 3. Students who complete their degrees at Suffolk County Community College are exempt from taking any entrance examination.

VI. Scholarships

- 1. Every Suffolk County Community College graduate will receive an initial, \$1,500 transfer scholarship upon registration at Five Towns College, in addition to other scholarships which they may be eligible to receive.
- 2. Suffolk County Community College graduates, who will enroll full time (12 or more credits) at Five Towns College in any degree program, will be eligible for a merit scholarship.

The basic criteria for such merit Scholarships will be awarded for GPA in excess of 3.0 starting at \$5,000 annually and will be based on a sliding scale, based on the number of competed credits.

Students with a GPA of 3.0-3.1 will receive \$5,000 per year. Students with a GPA of 3.2-3.5 will receive \$5,500 per year.

Students with a GPA of 3.6-4.0 will receive \$6,000 per year.

- 3. Suffolk County Community College graduates will be eligible for additional talent-based scholarships, scholarships to be awarded in Music or Theatre based upon the student's audition performance ranging from \$1,000-\$7,000 per year.
- 4. Five Towns College will set aside departmental scholarships for qualified Suffolk County Community College graduates who will register as full time students at Five Towns College. Five Towns College will set aside \$1,000 to \$5,000 in department scholarships in each discipline for qualified full time students in Theatre Arts, Business, Childhood Education or Journalism.
