

# Joint Admissions Agreement between Suffolk County Community College and St. Joseph's University

## **I. Purpose:**

This is a Joint Admissions Agreement ("Agreement") between Suffolk County Community College (hereinafter "Suffolk"), located at 533 College Road, Selden, New York 11784 and St. Joseph's University (hereinafter "St. Joseph's"), located at 155 W. Roe Blvd., Patchogue, New York 11772. This Agreement establishes the terms, procedures and plan of coursework for Suffolk students who would like to obtain the associated Bachelor's degree at St. Joseph's after graduating Suffolk. Furthermore, this Agreement embraces the principle that transfer students should not be required to repeat competencies already achieved. The purpose of this agreement is to guarantee admissions into specified programs as long as the stated criteria is met.

Under this Agreement, Associate degree graduates admitted into St. Joseph's will have junior status enabling them to complete the requirements for a Bachelor's degree in a minimum of four semesters of full-time work if the suggested course sequence is followed. Graduates will be awarded credits as specified in the transfer guides, subject to St. Joseph's specific program and/or institutional requirements. A minimum grade of D will be considered for transfer credit, only if the course was part of a completed A.S. or A.A. degree. A minimum of a cumulative 2.0 GPA from Suffolk County Community College is required for consideration of admission to St. Joseph's University.

## **II. Eligibility**

### **The Joint Admissions Program is open to:**

- Applicants to Suffolk who will be first-time, matriculated freshmen; or
- Transfer applicants to Suffolk who will enter with twenty-four (24) credits or fewer of completed college work, except students who were previously matriculated at St. Joseph's; or
- Any current matriculated Suffolk student who applies to the Joint Admissions Program with 24 or fewer credits of college work

Credits awarded by transfer from another institution or by exam will be evaluated individually according to St. Joseph's University's published policies.

### **Articulation for Transfer Students Not Eligible for Joint Admissions**

Suffolk students not covered by this Agreement are still eligible to seek admission to St. Joseph's through the regular admissions process by applying and by meeting the admissions standards of St. Joseph's. Non-joint admission graduates will still be awarded credits as specified in the transfer guides, subject to St. Joseph's specific program and/or institutional requirements. Only courses completed with a grade of C- or higher will be accepted in transfer, unless that course was part of a completed A.S. or A.A. program, then a grade of D may be accepted for transfer credit.

As part of this Joint Admission agreement, students who have completed a Suffolk program listed in Section III with the specified minimum GPA and any additional admissions requirements, are guaranteed admission into the associated program. These students are provided junior status and the opportunity to complete the baccalaureate degree in a minimum of two additional years of full-time study at St. Joseph's if the suggested course sequence is followed. For effective transfer, students can follow St. Joseph's University Core Curriculum as provided in Appendix I.

### III. Program Table:

The following program table will be applicable to the Joint Admissions Agreement. Please see Appendix II for specific details regarding equivalencies for each program.

#### IV. St. Joseph's Responsibilities:

- a. Publicize this Agreement to students, faculty, and professional staff in campus publications.
- b. Provide a table on St. Joseph's website with each program's course equivalencies.
- c. Designate a contact from the Office of Undergraduate Admission for Suffolk students transferring to St. Joseph's University.
- d. Provide on-site information sessions on Suffolk's campuses for interested students.
- e. Provide information sessions on Suffolk's campuses to jointly admitted students.

- f. Provide information on degree changes as they become available.
- g. Review all applications from Suffolk students. Provided the recommended course selection in Appendix II has been fulfilled by the Suffolk student, and the student has graduated with the required GPA and has met all admission criteria, admission to St. Joseph's shall be granted to the student. Suffolk students who are unable to satisfy an admission requirement may be considered by St. Joseph's on a case-by-case basis.
- h. Suffolk students admitted to the Joint Admissions Program will enjoy the following benefits:
  - a. Waiver of St. Joseph's application fee
  - b. Waiver of requirement to submit essay and letters of recommendation with admissions application
  - c. Receipt of St. Joseph's welcome letter
  - d. St. Joseph's will invite students to visit and tour the St. Joseph's campus; attend academic, cultural and athletic events; participate in admissions events and meet on an individual basis with St. Joseph's advisors.
  - e. Early registration access, provided that St. Joseph's has received the non-refundable tuition deposit by the published deadline.
- i. Provide a report to Suffolk each semester that tracks the number of students entering each pathway within the joint admissions program and each pathway for students not signed up for joint admissions.

#### **V. Suffolk Responsibilities**

- a. Suffolk will list St. Joseph's on the Suffolk application as a joint admissions option.
- b. Publicize this Agreement to students, faculty and professional staff in campus publications.
- c. Assure that brochures and other printed materials provided by St. Joseph's are distributed to Suffolk's transfer office, counseling center and academic departments.
- d. Have advisors and counselors inform interested students of this opportunity.
- e. Organize a Transfer Day for students to meet with St. Joseph's advisors. Transfer Day may occur on the Suffolk campus, St. Joseph's campus or virtually.
- f. Suffolk will be responsible for selection of candidates to the Joint Admissions Program. Applications will be evaluated according to the basic criteria in effect at Suffolk.
- g. On or about October 15<sup>th</sup> and February 15<sup>th</sup> of each year, Suffolk will provide St. Joseph's with a list of all students with 30 credits or more participating in the Joint Admissions Program. The list will include the following information: majors, total completed credits, address, phone numbers and Suffolk student email addresses (if available). Suffolk's Dean of Enrollment Management will serve as the contact point for any student data or information associated with this Agreement.

#### **VI. Scholarship Opportunities**

Students in the Joint Admissions Program will automatically be considered for transfer scholarships, merit-based grants, and Phi Theta Kappa scholarships at St. Joseph's. Additional scholarship opportunities may be available within specific majors.

### **Merit Scholarships**

St. Joseph's University offers competitive scholarships for transfer students who have a minimum GPA of 2.8. 2024-2025 Awards range from \$10,000 to \$15,000 and can be offered for the length of study as outlined below:

2.8 – 2.99	\$10,000
3.0 – 3.39	\$12,000
3.4 – 3.69	\$14,000
3.7 – 4.00	\$15,000

### **Stay on Long Island Initiative Program**

Additionally, as part of the SCCC Stay on Long Island Initiative Program, St. Joseph's University offers the following scholarships:

#### **Fall Semester:**

- Three full tuition scholarships (one per SCCC Campus)
- Six \$20,000 scholarships (two per SCCC Campus)

#### **Spring Semester:**

- One full tuition scholarship
- Two \$20,000 scholarships

### **Phi Theta Kappa (National Honor Society for Community Colleges)**

Students with a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA immediately after receiving a two-year degree are eligible for this award. Proof of membership must be submitted to the Office of Admissions. A maximum of ten \$1,000 scholarships per year are awarded upon graduation from Suffolk County Community College.


**VII. Updates and Terms of Agreement**

In the event it is decided at any time to terminate this Agreement, commitments made to the individual Suffolk student already in the Joint Admissions program will be honored in accordance with the provisions of this agreement.



## Appendix I: St. Joseph's University Core Curriculum

### Common Learning Area

**ENG 103 - Writing for Effective Communication** - Analysis and application of the principles of effective writing. Skills developed in the performance of various writing tasks. Research techniques are also implemented.

**SJNY 200 - Transfer Seminar** - This one-credit course will introduce new transfer students to the mission and goals of St. Joseph's University. Additionally, students will explore learning and research skills, opportunities for campus and community involvement, and the nature of the liberal arts as envisioned by SJNY. This course is required of all transfer students as a vital part of the process of becoming familiar with the ethos of St. Joseph's University and helping them to integrate into our social and learning environment.

### Thematic Learning Areas

**Quest for Meaning (2 courses)** - Course offerings in this area examine various human attempts to understand the nature of such values as truth, beauty, goodness, justice, and love; and invite students to engage in a systematic examination of such core human questions as: Who am I? Why do I exist? What can I know? How can I be a good person? For what can I hope? And even to question these questions.

**Global Perspectives (2 courses)** - Course offerings in this area are designed to broaden the perspective of the student to include knowledge of world cultures, traditions, and peoples facilitated by the study of a range of global topics presented in courses from diverse disciplines.

**Self & Society (3 courses: one history, two other social/behavioral sciences)** - Course offerings in this area seek to understand the person within these broad communal and temporal horizons. They examine the reciprocal relationship between the individual and society, situating personal dynamics within a study of the prevailing social, political and economic realities and a historical understanding of how those factors came to be.

**The Mathematical, Physical, & Natural World (3 courses: one math, one lab science, one additional)** - Course offerings in this area invite students to engage in critical thinking and problem solving in the realm of science and mathematics. These courses will provide students with the skills that will enable them to interact effectively with the physical and natural world of the sciences and the abstract world of mathematics.

**Human Expression (2 courses)** - Course offerings in this area develop an understanding of humankind through a wide range of literary, cultural, and aesthetic expressions. Students will also acquire skills to express themselves artistically and verbally and to appreciate the range of artistic expression throughout the human community.

### **Integrated Learning Areas (3 of 5 areas)**

**Writing Intensive (2 courses)** - Course offerings and experiences in this area will shape students into strong writers by developing their critical and creative reading, thinking, and writing abilities associated with expression and composition.

**Technology Integrated** - Course offerings and experiences in this area will develop the students' ability to adapt, navigate and become proficient in at least 3 technological areas: communication and collaboration, creativity and innovation, critical thinking, problem solving, decision making, digital citizenship, technology concepts and digital tools. These areas are fluid in nature and thus students' experiences will reflect the constantly changing technologies, applications and systems in our global society.

**SJNY Learning Communities** - Course offerings and experiences in this area emphasize cooperative learning experiences that link courses, curricular material, faculty, or student with the aim of promoting deep learning and engagement with other members of the University community.

**Service & Experiential Learning** - Course offerings or activities in this area may include a variety of options designed to supplement and complement the purely academic and theoretical. Structured experiences will encourage educational interaction and participation in supervised and collaborative ventures that will identify specific learning goals that promote the development of knowledge, skills, and dispositions associated with the liberal arts and the professions.

**Diversity Integrated** - Course offerings in this area are designed to: incorporate elements related to a variety of human differences; explore the differences among various groups and forms of human expression in our society; examine the richness and strengths of complex, heterogeneous societies, while confronting the intolerance, inequality, and conflict that often accompany diversity. Courses will, in a substantial and rigorous manner, analyze topics and issues related to these aspects of diversity throughout the course.
