**ADDENDUM TO JOINT ADMISSIONS AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE
AND
STONY BROOK UNIVERSITY**

This Addendum is made a part of the Joint Admissions Agreement between Suffolk County Community College (Suffolk) and Stony Brook University (Stony Brook) signed by both institutions in July 2025, hereinafter referred to as the "Original Agreement."

Both parties agree to add the Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Occupational Therapy Assistant (OTA) at Suffolk to the original Appendix A that lists the Joint Admissions Programs of Study at Suffolk and note that it aligns well with the BS in Health Science at Stony Brook. However, Suffolk OTA students may choose to transfer to other programs at Stony Brook if they meet the requirements, as stated in the Original Agreement. An updated Appendix A is enclosed hereto and shall replace Appendix A which was annexed to the Original Agreement.

Students who complete an Associate in Applied Science degree in Occupational Therapy Assistant Program at Suffolk with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.8 and earn grades of C or higher in Anatomy & Physiology I and II, equivalent to HAN 200 and HAN 202 at Stony Brook, will be guaranteed admission to the major in Health Science. Upon matriculation, students must complete the Health Science major declaration workshop/survey, within their first semester at Stony Brook University.

It is understood by Suffolk and Stony Brook that all other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement will remain unchanged, except for the specified terms and conditions as stated in this Addendum.
