⁶Childhood Education majors at Old Westbury take a 32-credit concentration in one of the following fields: American Studies, Biology, Chemistry, English, History, Mathematics, Politics Economics & Law, Spanish, Visual Arts, and World Cultures. Students are encouraged to speak with a transfer representative from Old Westbury to assist in selecting the course to meet this requirement.

Note: This degree requires a full semester (12 credits) of student teaching in the final semester. This degree will take 2.5 years to complete. Students can opt into the Special Education Childhood degree or the Bilingual extension of either the Childhood Education or Special Education Childhood degrees, but those degrees will take an additional half year to a year of study.
