<sup>2</sup>Students are required to complete two semesters of a foreign language in sequence based on completion of prerequisite or fulfillment of equivalent high school placement requirements, as follows: Elementary I/Elementary II or Elementary II/Intermediate I or Intermediate I/Intermediate II or Intermediate II/any advanced-level course.

<sup>3</sup>To be chosen with advice of Philosophy Department advisor. Students enrolled in the Philosophy option must take at least one course in each of the following areas: I. Reasoning (PHL104: Critical Thinking; PHL105: Logic); II. Values (PHL107: Ethics; PHL211: Biomedical Ethics; PHL212: Ethics Issues in Business; PHL216: Philosophy of the Arts); and III. History (PHL111: World Philosophies; PHL201: History of Ancient and Medieval Philosophy; PHL202: History of Modern Philosophy).
